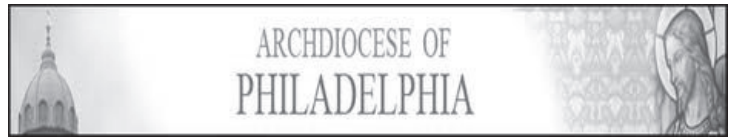


# PARISH NEWS



## A "JUBILEE DOOR" AT OUR LADY OF LOURDES



As part of the celebration to mark the 800th Anniversary of the Mercedarian Order our Master General requested, from the Holy See, a special blessing and indulgence upon the Order and the faithful celebrating this great event. His Eminence, Cardinal Mauro Piacenza, the Major Penitentiary of the Church, acting in the name of Pope Francis issued this special blessing and indulgence immediately. This special period of celebration and grace began January 17, 2018 and will officially end January 17, 2019. During this time the members of the Order and the faithful can gain a special **plenary indulgence**, and this can be applied to the living or deceased. To gain this indulgence the faithful need to participate in a jubilee celebration or visit a chapel or church that is under the care of the Mercedarian Order and fulfill the usual conditions for the indulgence, namely: sacramental confession, reception of Holy Communion, and praying for the Holy Father and his intentions. Each of the churches or chapels will have a door designated as the Jubilee Door that the faithful can pass through in entering to pray and celebrate this great jubilee. This weekend we officially bless and open the Jubilee Door for our parish for this event.
