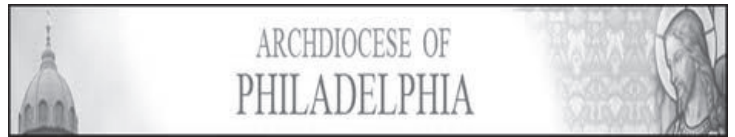

A second collection will be held at all Masses next weekend in support of **Holy Family Hospital of Bethlehem.**

Holy Family Hospital is the only state-of-the-art maternity and child care hospital in the war-torn and impoverished area of Bethlehem in Palestine. The hospital is located 500 yards from the birth place of our Lord and ensures that there will always be "ROOM IN THE INN" for the women and babies of the area. It is operated by the Order of Malta at the direction of Saint John Paul II. It is an instrument of peace in the region and a beacon of hope for the thousands of mothers and children who are treated every year. This modern-day manger is sustained by generous donations from individuals and parishes and delivers over 4,700 babies a year. It costs only \$250 to deliver a baby at the hospital. A life can be saved for \$250!

Representatives of the Order of Malta and Holy Family Hospital will be in the Narthex to answer any questions and receive your donations.

The Order has also offered to accept any petitions you may want delivered during their upcoming May pilgrimage to the Grotto of Our Lady of Lourdes in France. Petition forms will be available at the narthex.
