Dear parishioners,

It is hard to believe that this is August! Soon children will be preparing to return to school and vacations will be coming to an end. This is a very good moment then to call to mind to points; first our parish *Religious Education Program*. At Our Lady of Lourdes Parish the children celebrate their First Penance and First Eucharist in the 3rd grade. Every child, regardless of where you attend school *MUST* take part in this program if you are a 3rd grade student. If you attend public school this is a weekly program. Those attending Catholic school or those home schooled attend once a month. Registration forms will be available beginning next week. This year we also celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. This program is for students in 5th and 6th grade and the same attendance rules apply as the First Eucharist program

My second point concerns those children attending Catholic school. Each year the parish pays thousands of dollars in subsidy to the schools you attend to assist in keeping the tuition cost low for families. I have no problem doing this but in return two things are expected; first, that you attend Mass here at OLL on regular basis every Sunday. Secondly, the boys are asked to participate as servers at Mass and the girls are asked to participate in the Bernadette's program here at the parish. For those who find these requirements too burdensome please let me know because we will not pay the subsidy to your school.

MOMENT IN OLL HISTORY - IRISH DAY 1976

August 7, 1976, while several Cardinals from around the world were gathered in Philadelphia, PA for the Eucharistic Congress, Msgr. Rilley, the Pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes, organized an "Irish Day" for the Cardinals while staying at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary. Msgr. Rilley accompanied the then Cardinal of Krakow, Poland, Cardinal Karol Wojtyla to visit Our Lady of Lourdes Church and gave him a three hour tour of Lourdes Church, Grotto and grounds. A short two years after this visit, Cardinal Wojtyla became the Successor of Peter and the Vicar of Christ: Pope John Paul II. This moment in OLL history is confirmed by Rev. John Dinda who was present at the "Irish Day," August 7th, 1976 and remembers well Wojtyla's visit to Lourdes.

CONSECRATION OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF PHILADELPHIA TO THE BLESSED MOTHER

The Bishops of Pennsylvania voted to approve a recommendation that each Catholic diocese and eparchy in the Commonwealth be dedicated to the Blessed Mother in honor of the 100th Anniversary of the apparition of the Blessed Mother at Fatima. The official dedication will be marked with a special Mass to be celebrated in Saint Patrick Cathedral in Harrisburg at 12:00 noon on Wednesday, **September 27** by all bishops in the state. The second part of the dedication will be an observance in each diocese. The Archdiocese of Philadelphia will be consecrated to Our Lady on the weekend of October 14-15 at the Cathedral in Philadelphia. More details will be coming soon.
