CONSECRATION OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF PHILADELPHIA TO THE BLESSED MOTHER

The Bishops of Pennsylvania voted to approve a recommendation that each Catholic diocese and eparchy in the Commonwealth be dedicated to the Blessed Mother in honor of the 100th Anniversary of the apparition of the Blessed Mother at Fatima. The official dedication will be marked with a special Mass to be celebrated in Saint Patrick Cathedral in Harrisburg at 12:00 noon on **Wednesday, September 27** by all bishops in the state. The second part of the dedication will be an observance in each diocese. The Archdiocese of Philadelphia will be consecrated to Our Lady on the weekend of **October 14-15 at the Cathedral in Philadelphia**. More details will be coming soon.

* Buses to Harrisburg will depart on Wednesday, September 27, 2017 at 7:30am from St Jude, Chalfont, PA 215-822-0179 and at 8am from St. Maria Goretti, Hatfield, PA 215-721-0199. Cost: \$20/person. There will be a lunch stop after Mass (bring your own snacks).
